## The Ivory Bangle Lady: Fact Sheet

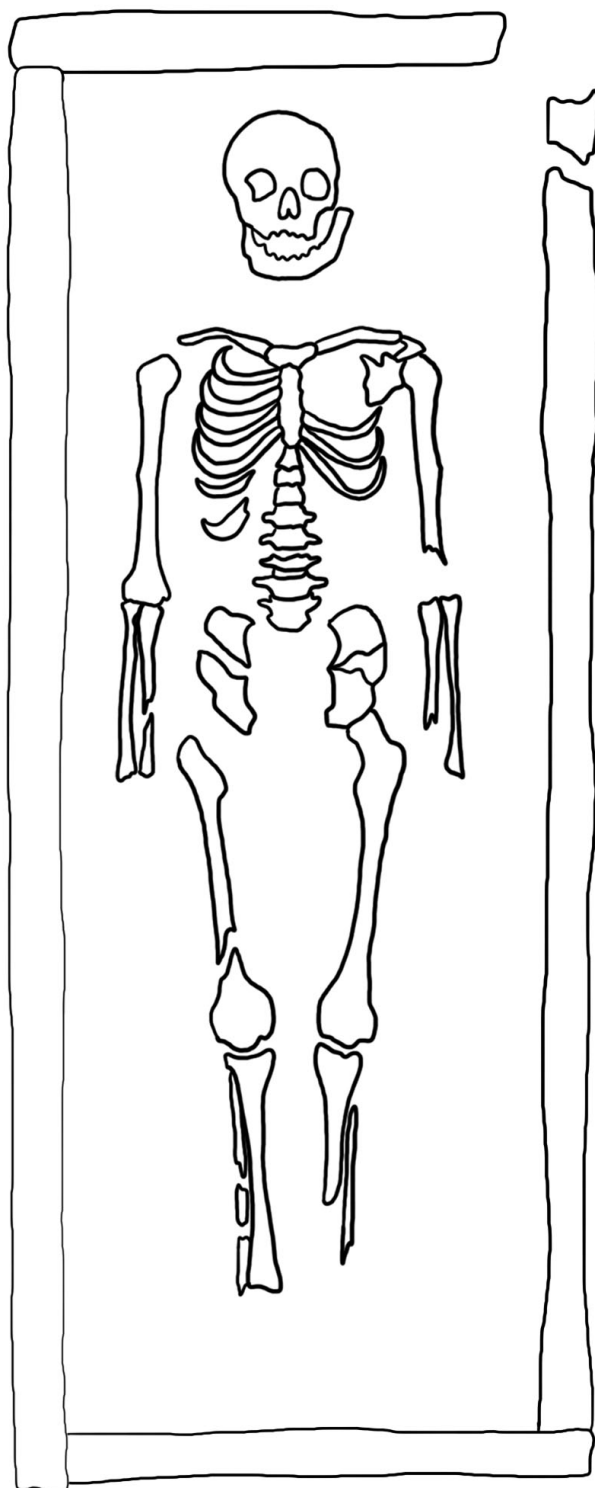
The **Ivory Bangle Lady** was discovered by **archaeologists** in a **sarcophagus** in York. She is thought to be 18 - 23 years old and archaeologists think that she might be **Christian** or **Roman Pagan**. **Forensic scientists** think that she was from North Africa and moved during her childhood to the west of Britain. She was buried in York towards the end of Roman rule in Britain. In the **sarcophagus** there are several precious items which came from all over the Roman Empire!

The skeleton of the Ivory Bangle Lady in her sarcophagus.



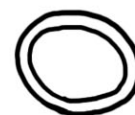
